As the sun began its descent, and shoes still squelching with water, our merry band of adventurers clambered aboard their buses to head back home.




Exhausted, exhilarated, and a tad sunkissed, all returned with stories, souvenirs, and wide, satisfied grins.


















## Stars in the Spotlight: (Term 3) Stellar Certificates Presented to Top Performers!

With wide-eyed wonder, the LKG students wowed and wooed as they watched their seniors — primed for Primary — take flight into a new chapter of learning!




